OF THE HAZARD CODE OF ORDINANCES

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 52.11-52.13 OF THE HAZARD CODE REGARDING THE GAS RATES FOR CUSTOMERS

WHEREAS, the City Commission wishes to adjust the gas rates in accordance with CPI, or amount less than CPI,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF HAZARD, KENTUCKY, AS FOLLOWS:

§ 52.11 RATES FOR CUSTOMERS LOCATED INSIDE CITY.

Effective with the billing for gas deliveries commencing on February 1, 2025, the rates for customers inside the city shall be:

- (A) Commercial and residential customers - per MCF.

1	\$12.88
5	\$12.83
10	\$12.80
20	\$12.76
100 or above	\$12.72

§ 52.12 RATES FOR CUSTOMERS LOCATED OUTSIDE CITY.

Effective with the billing for gas deliveries to customers outside the city commencing on February 1, 2025 but excluding customers of the Coal Fields Regional Industrial Park Pipeline, the rates for customers outside the city shall be:

- (A) Commercial and residential customers - per MCF.

100 or above	\$12.72

§ 52.13 RATES FOR CUSTOMERS ON THE COAL FIELDS REGIONAL INDUSTRIAL PARK PIPELINE.

(A) Effective with the billing for gas deliveries to customers outside the city commencing on February 1, 2025 the rates for customers of the city shall be:

1	\$12.88
5	\$12.83
10	\$12.80
20	\$12.76
100 or above	\$12.72

§ 52.14 CONSUMER PRICE INDEX ADJUSTMENT.

All the above consumer rates for commercial and residential gas service shall be subject to increase annually based on changes in the Consumer Price Index or an amount less than Consumer Price Index if voted on by Board of Commissioners, Commencing effective on February 1, 2021 and on February 1 in each year thereafter, the prevailing fixed rates for commercial and residential customers and the Add On Rate for industrial gas customers may be automatically adjusted annually for increases in the Consumer Price Index for All Urban Consumers (CPI-U); U.S. City Average; all items, not seasonally adjusted, 1982-1984=100 reference base, and the new effective rate shall be incorporated into the budget ordinance for that year and amend the rates reflected herein automatically.). If there is a decrease or no change in the Consumer Price Index (CPI-U) then there will be no change in gas rates for that year.
